#### A Research proposal and action plan

Criterion A should be used to assess the research proposal and action plan only.

Achievement level	Descriptor
0	There is no research proposal or action plan.
1	There is a research proposal and action plan. However, elements of the researc proposal or action plan are inappropriate.
2	The research proposal and action plan are generally appropriate, but they are reclear and focused.
3	The research proposal and action plan are appropriate, dear and focused. There is some identification of the theoretical framework and methodology to be employed.
4	The research proposal and action plan are appropriate, clear and focused. Their is clear identification and explanation of the theoretical framework an methodology to be employed.



### The Research Proposal/Action Plan

The internal assessment must start with the research proposal and action plan. These will become the primary planning documents, giving direction to the research project. It must outline...

- the research question
- the rationale for study
- · areas of the syllabus to be covered
- · possible sources of information
- · organizations and individuals to be approached
- methods to be used to collect and analyse data, and the reason for choosing them
- anticipated difficulties
- the order of activities and timescale of the project.



#### **Format**

Required format for research proposal and action plan

- Research guestion
- Theoretical framework.
- Methodology
- Anticipated difficulties
- Action plan

Students should use the research proposal and action plan as their primary planning documents, reviewing them regularly with the teacher and modifying or rewriting them as necessary should circumstances change.
